**Save Our Sonoma Roads Endorses
David Rabbitt for Sonoma County Supervisor**

SOSroads endorses David Rabbitt for 2nd District Sonoma County Supervisor. David has served as supervisor for 12 years. He offers continuity and proven road advocacy leadership for Petaluma and south county.

“David Rabbitt has been a relentless advocate to find funds to refurbish the county’s crumbling road system since SOSroads began over a decade ago,” said Craig S. Harrison, Co-Founder of SOSroads. “His leadership has boosted county funding for pavement preservation tenfold, making Sonoma County the most generous contributor of county general funds to roads in California.”

“David’s leadership, and the support of other supervisors, is a primary reason that 456 miles of county roads will have been refurbished between 2012 and 2023,” Co-Founder Michael Troy added. “His leadership also enabled the widening of Highway 101, our county’s main transportation artery.”

When SOSroads began in 2011, our road system was among the worst in California because supervisors had neglected their core responsibility to maintain and rehabilitate it for decades.

Supervisor Rabbitt turned this around, directing funding to roads and adopting creative solutions to refurbish our road infrastructure. He coauthored Sonoma County’s first long term road plan, and has helped direct \$128 million so far to implementing it.

SOSroads wants to avoid backsliding on refurbishing our county road system, and is delighted to endorse David Rabbitt for county supervisor.
